## **6. NORTH LINCOLNSHIRE COUNCIL MATTERS**

- i) To receive report from Cllr D Oldfield: The North Lincolnshire Council AGM was held today – 10/5/16 – with Cllr Foster being made mayor and Cllr P Clark deputy mayor. It was announced that Cllr L Redfern will step down as leader of the council next year. The flytipping on farmers lane – reported last meeting – was cleared away very quickly. The Lincolnshire lakes project was finally adopted by the council today and will provide 6,300 new houses within 6 new villages. Flood protection improvements are still high on Cllr Oldfield's list of priorities.

- ii) Parish Bus Service – Helen Reek of N.L.C has put together a proposal for a bus service which satisfies the needs of the residents in the parish. This is to be considered by N.L.C in due course.
- iii) New matters: Members of the parish have requested a crossing (pedestrian) on Burringham Road between the ASDA roundabout and the new development of 71 homes at Ashby Decoy. They have also requested a footpath between The Mallard Public House and the new development at Ashby Decoy. Clerk to make this request to highways at N.L.C.

The parish council have been asked to consider making a donation to the Ashfield and Parklands Neighbourhood watch group. The group feel they need approximately £60 to run two meetings per year. This will be an agenda item for consideration at the next parish council meeting. Cllr Oldfield advised the meeting that Ashfield and Parklands neighbourhood watch group is one of the best attended groups in the area and perhaps a condition of the donation from the parish council would be that everyone is welcome to attend the meetings.

It was reported that children/youths are bringing rubbish to the lagoon area – a skip of rubbish has been filled but more rubbish keeps appearing in this area. It is hoped that the problem will resolve itself in due course.
