## 6. NORTH LINCOLNSHIRE COUNCIL MATTERS

- i) To receive report from Cllr D Oldfield: The second phase of the Lincolnshire Lakes development proposals have been submitted and are available to view on line.

N.L.C are undertaking a consultation on Scunthorpe being a 'Garden City Status'.

There is a new 'Call Connect' bus service for rural areas – connecting rural areas to a transport hub for travel further afield.

No progress has been made regarding the proposed bus service – Cllr Oldfield will chase up with Lynn Watson and Helen Reek.

Three coaches took residents from Burringham and Gunness areas to Bridlington for a day trip. The trip was very well supported by local residents.

Cllr Oldfield now sits on the Gainsborough and Scunthorpe Water Management Board.

- ii) Pedestrian Crossing on Burringham Road – this will not be considered until the new houses are built and the need assessed.
- iii) Footpath between the Mallard public house and the new Ashby Decoy development – this will not be considered until the new houses are built and the need assessed.
- iv) New matters to report: No new matters to report.

## 7. LOCAL or SITE MATTERS.

- i) NATS meeting – At the last meeting Cllr Vessey raised the flooding issue at the bus stop at Ashfiled – ASDA side and the vibration problems from the building site.
- ii) Parish Bus Service – No update available.
- iii) New matters: It was reported that 2 people were sleeping rough at the lagoon – The Police attended and took them away (moved for their own safety) but they won't move the fishermen on or check their rod licences – as they say it is private land. Cllr Oldfield was asked, when he attends the next Water Board meeting, to raise this matter and ask the water Board if they will instruct someone to check rod licences. It is unlikely that the Water Board will engage in this matter.

There is a pony tethered on the gymkhana field – it has been reported to the Police but they do not want to know. The owner of the field will be informed and it was suggested that this matter be reported to the RSPCA. Cllr Holloway suggested that the owner of the field be reminded to cut some fire breaks into the field this summer.
