- i) To receive report from Cllr D Oldfield- It was reported that the flytipping/ rubbish has been cleared – thanks to Cllr Waters and a resident
Flood protection measures are being instigated in the area – which is beneficial to all concerned. The Lincolnshire lakes development is commencing with the farm house having being demolished.
