**7. North Lincolnshire council matters:**

i) To receive report from Cllr J Walshe: Speed loops will be placed on Burringham Road to monitor traffic volume and speed. The loops will be down for 4 – 10 weeks and then if the data provides the evidence speed prevention methods will be instigated.

N.L.C are conducting a study on the ASDA roundabout to see if any improvements can be made to particularly with regard to the ASDA exit route.

N.L.C have applied for funding of up to £25m for improvements to Scunthorpe High Street/centre.

ii) Any new N.L.C matters to report: Cllr Devine asked Cllr Walshe for a poster with his contact details which the clerk was able to provide. This will be placed on the notice boards.

**8. Local or Site Matters**

i) NATS meeting – Traffic speeds has been removed as a priority until the data from the speed loops has been received and analysed. N.L.C is supporting a community speed watch initiative, instigated by Humberside Police, where local volunteers are trained to use a speed camera and report persistently offending drivers to the Police who will issue, in the first instance, a caution.

Hilton Avenue has suffered a number of breakins. The Police are clamping down on children riding motorbikes – residents must report any incidents to the police.

ii) Recognition of local volunteer – It was agreed to purchase a voucher for the volunteer to the value of £30 – taken from the chairman's allowance. Cllr Waters to organise

iii) Summer coach trips – both the summer coach trips went very well. The coaches have been paid for.

iv) Any new local or site matters to report: It was noted that tree branches are infringing – or close to – power lines to the rear of Ashfield. The branches have been cut back in the past – these overhead power lines will be on an inspection schedule by the utility company.
