

Minutes of a meeting of Ashby Parkland Parish Council held on Monday 10th January 2022 at 6pm in Gunness Village Hall.

2. **DECLARATION OF INTEREST ON ANY AGENDA ITEM** – None.

3. **ADOPTION OF THE MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 8th NOVEMBER 2021**

Proposed by Cllr D Oldfield, seconded by Cllr B Holloway and agreed unanimously.

4. **CLERKS UPDATES**

- Overgrown trees and shrubbery on land belonging to the IDB (Lagoon area) at the back of the Ashfield site and Capps Coal Yard – update on creating fire break
Cllr Walshe has spoken to Capps but no improvements have been made as yet. The Clerk has written to Capps to ask if they can maintain a fire break on their land but has not received a response. The clerk contacted the IDB and asked them to contact The Chairman to arrange a meeting to discuss the problem but as yet no one from the IDB has made contact.

- b) To receive Income and Expenditure year to date sheet – circulated prior to the meeting and transactions noted.

c) To discuss and set the precept for 2022/23.

The clerk circulated a paper to help with the discussion in setting the precept for the next financial year.

Cllr Oldfield suggested that a sum of money should be ring fenced for ‘community development’.

MOTION: To set the precept for 2022/23 at £4,500 – proposed by Cllr Oldfield, seconded by Cllr Devine and unanimously agreed.

7. North Lincolnshire council matters:

i) Bus Services within the parish – The ‘Just Go’ bus promotion/road show took place in November and approximately 10/15 people attended the road show. It was noted that the ‘Fixed Services’ are not likely to be increased so it is important that residents are familiar with and use the ‘just Go’ service. Cllr Walshe felt that the road show had increased residents awareness of the service and hopefully these residents will now use this ‘Just Go’ bus service.

ii) Any new N.L.C matters to report- Cllr Hollaway advised the meeting that the gullies on Burringham road are blocked with mud and silt and that the soil is at the same height as the curb and therefore a road sweeper will not move the debris. The mud/soil needs physically removing with a spade. Cllr Walshe will report this matter.

A discussion took place regarding the change in ownership of the Ashfield site. Unfortunately the site was not gritted in the recent icy weather but this is not a legal requirement for the site owners to grit the site. N.L.C are in discussions with the site owners and are looking at the license detail and it is hoped that a representative of Ting Dene will come to the site to meet residents in due course.

8. Parish Matters

a) NATS meeting – The next NATS meeting is scheduled for 17/1/22 at 2pm and this is likely to be a remote meeting.

b) Social event for residents of the parish to be held at the golf club – 112 tickets were sold and the evening was a great success. A rafle was held and £100 was donated to Lindsey Lodge Hospice. It is hoped that a similar event can be held in 2022.

c) Ashfield Park Residents Association and Neighborhood Watch Scheme – A coordinator has been appointed and the cheme/organization is progressing.

d) Ting Dene Parks – meeting room – It is unlikely that the new site owners will provide a meeting/community room.

e) Any new local or site matters – Cllr Walshe advised the meeting of a virtual drainage meeting with Ashfield park representatives, ASDA representatives, Severn trent Water and the IDB. A Government Agency will undertake a study/map survey the area from the lagoon to The Trent to identify weak spots and agree improvements. A full survey will be undertaken on the whole system.
