7. North Lincolnshire council matters:

- a) Report from Ward Councillor J Walshe : Cllr Walshe congratulated Mr S Black on being successfully co-opted to Ashby Parkland Parish Council. The next NATS meeting is scheduled for 8/8/23 at 2pm in Gunness Village Hall. Cllr Walshe advised that just about all the energy grants have been paid out to Park Home residents. The problems with the street lighting has been sorted out on Ashfield Park. A discussion took place regarding the possibility of a reduction in height of the street lighting on Ashfield Park – this is a site matter not a N.L.C matter. Work on the Southern roundabout is due to start in the next couple of months.

The hedge running from Ashfield to Lindsey Lodge has not yet been cut but the farmer has been asked to make this a priority.

- b) Any new N.L.C matters to report: The litter bin at the bus shelter outside ASDA's has been removed/stolen – Cllr Walshe will ask N.L.C to replace this bin.

8. Parish Matters

- a) NATS meeting – The next NATS meeting is scheduled for 8/8/23 – 2pm – Gunness Village hall.
- b) Ashfield Park Residents Association and Neighborhood Watch Scheme: Both groups are progressing well.
- c) Parklands Neighbourhood Watch Scheme – Cllr Devine reported that the proceeds from the raffle held on the recent coach trip will be donated to Parklands Neighbourhood Watch. It was reported that motorbikes are a problem on the Parklands site – damaging grass etc – this has been reported to the police but unfortunately no police presence has been visible on the site or vicinity. Cllr Walshe advised that operation yellow fin has successfully seized more than 30 bikes. This matter will be made a priority at the next NATS meeting. Concerns were also expressed regarding fires being lit in close proximity to the park homes. Cllr Holloway suggested that these concerns should be raised on the safer neighbourhoods surveys which are frequently sent round to residents – this will alert the police to visit/take action/recognize this problem.
- d) Planters – The planter has been made and erected on ASDA's side of the road – opposite Woodside Drive. This will make watering etc easier for residents. This will be planted up very shortly.
- e) Summer Coach trip – The coach trip has taken place and was a success.
- f) Any new local or site matters: No new matters raised.
